COVID 19- precautionary measures

Due to the ongoing situation around COVID-19, the following will be implemented with immediate effect and until further notice;

- Ships calling at Loch Ryan Port will have to notify the Harbour master if they have a person onboard showing symptoms of COVID-19
- Contractors to the port or a ship visiting the port, will need to seek clearance from the Harbour Master or his deputy and submit below form before being allowed on site. Failure to do so will prevent the person or contractor from gaining access to the port.
- Regular contractors will have to report to the Harbour Master or his deputy if they become aware of anyone of their work force showing symptoms associated with COVID-19
